



JOB POSTING: Welcome Home Intern

Ray of Hope is currently seeking a male intern to work in a live-in position on a male residential unit with our Refugee Services (**Welcome Home**) program for a 9 month paid assignment, starting at the end of August and completing at the end of May.

Overview:

The Welcome Home Intern will be responsible for building relationships with residents through providing personal support and welcome assistance as they foster community between everyone living at Welcome Home. This is a live-in position whereby they will oversee and supervise the daily operations of the Welcome Home house including household life, guidelines, household rules, and facilitate programming. They will provide leadership in spiritual care and support through practically sharing the Christian faith, while living in a multi-faith environment.

 - Previous experience working with refugees is an asset

- Certifications:
 - Level C CPR/AED, First aid training is required.
- Skills/Abilities:
 - Fluent in English, both written and orally
 - Demonstrated ability to manage crisis situations
 - Demonstrated time management and organizational skills
 - Ability to working within a multi-cultural, multi-faith environment ensuring that the utmost respect is afforded.
 - Demonstrated confidence in managing relationships between adults.
 - Demonstrated self-care abilities and ability to manage need for personal space in a communal living environment.

Requirements:

- Police Records Check, including a screening with the vulnerable sector.
- Medical Form
- Valid “G” Class Driver’s licence
- Ministry of Transportation 3-Year Driving Record
- Completion of a crisis intervention training program
- This position requires the successful candidate to provide leadership, direction and implement Christian values in a multi-faith environment. The successful candidate is required to sign off agreeing to our Statement of Faith and Morality Statement.
