



JOB POSTING WELCOME HOME REFUGEE HOUSE INTERN

Ray of Hope is currently seeking a male intern to work in a live-in position in a male unit with Welcome Home Refugee House for a one year assignment, starting at the beginning of September.

Overview: The Welcome Home Intern will be responsible for building relationships with residents through providing personal support and welcome assistance as they foster community between everyone living at Welcome Home. This is a live-in position whereby they will oversee and supervise the daily operations of the Welcome Home house including household life, guidelines and ensuring household rules are being followed. They will provide leadership in spiritual care and support through practically sharing the Christian faith, while living in a multi-faith environment and showing respect for other belief systems.

Competencies:

In order to be successful in this position, candidates must uphold, support, and implement Ray of Hope's Mission, Vision and Core Values in addition to the following competencies:

Qualifications:

- Education: Completion of or near completion Post-Secondary Education in Peace and Conflict Studies, Global Studies, International Development, Social Worker, Social Development Studies or other related discipline.
- Experience: Previous experience working with diverse cultures and oversea experience and experience working with refugees is an asset.
- Only male applicants will be considered at this time, as the incumbent will be living on the male residential unit and is required to support the clientele being served.

Successful candidates will be required to provide:

- Police Records Check, including a screening with the vulnerable sector.
- Medical Form
- Valid "G" Class Driver's licence, Ministry of Transportation 3-Year Driving Record
- A copy of a valid first aid/CPR (Level C minimum) certificate
- This position requires the successful candidate to provide leadership, direction and implement Christian values in a multi-faith environment. The successful candidate is required to sign off agreeing to our Statement of Faith and Morality Statement.
